The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Hosey made a motion to accept the minutes of the December 4, 2014 meeting. Commissioner Harris seconded.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE UPDATE

Sheriff Reich gave his appreciation to the Information System Department staff for their timely and professional service updating the department to the new network.

The Sheriff also updated the Committee on a new drug available to be administered to inmates under the influence of opiates. The drug only impacts an opiate overdose and has no adverse side effects, if an individual is not under the influence of opiates.

Discussion held on a communication received from Community Mental Health regarding a reduction in jail-based services resulting from State revenue reductions. This will effect having an afternoon therapist available. The current therapist will be on call until the situation is resolved.

The department is in the process of filling the remaining 2 vacant deputy positions.

Undersheriff Cook provided an update on recent case activity.

It was reported that January 9th has been designated as National Law Enforcement Appreciation Day.

Undersheriff Cook announced that the twenty-five new body worn cameras for the road patrol have been delivered. A policy is being developed using a model from the International Chiefs of Police Association. Deployment of the cameras is expected by the end of the month.

MONTHLY REPORTS

Controller Fuentes distributed and reviewed the boarding/revenue report.

Court Security and Jail Census report were also distributed and received.

CENTRAL DISPATCH UPDATE

Director Heinze updated the Committee on the hiring process for the new vacant dispatcher position will be starting soon and two other vacancies are in the process of being filled.

Director Heinze advised due to the addition of additional equipment to the Dispatch Tower and Rumsey Hill Tower structural improvements to the towers will be necessary to comply with FCC Regulations. The department has reviewed remediation options with Motorola. The required improvements will cost and estimated \$70,000. Discussion held.

Director Heinze further advised that funds are available however were unexpected and not included in the budget so a budget amendment will be required.

Commissioner Hosey made a motion to recommend to the Ways and Means Committee for Central Dispatch a budget amendment for the tower remediation improvements. Commissioner Harris seconded the motion.

Motion carried.

MISCELLANEOUS

Commissioner Whittum updated the Committee on the Jail Medical meeting where a discussion was held on flu vaccines for the 2015-16 year.

LIMITED PUBLIC COMMENT

Jeff Lutz from Davis Automart addressed the Committee on the elimination of the previous no-preference wrecker policy for Eaton County, and concerns that citizens are not being offered the opportunity to make a selection of towing providers.
