MINUTES OF JANUARY 7, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Commissioner Rogers made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 5, 2015 meeting with a correction on the agenda from December 3, 2015. Commissioner Hosey seconded. Motion Carried.

LIMITED PUBLIC COMMENT

Tony Sands from Countryside Towing advised that the towing company has expanded the heavy wrecker service.

Helen Schneider expressed her dissatisfaction with Senate Bill 571. She has contacted Senator Jones and would like the Commissioners to be aware of the intent of the bill.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE UPDATE

Undersheriff Cook provided an update on recent case activity.

Discussion held on the security contract that was cancelled by the Lansing Mall with the Sheriff's Office.

INMATE BOARDING REIMBURSEMENT UPDATE

Controller Fuentes advised that the yearly contract with Statewide Security for boarding inmates was up for renewal. A proposal was made to decrease the per inmate fee to \$29.00 per day from the \$35.00 per day current charge. The rate reduction is intended to be competitive with other facilities. The Sheriff's Office is seeking authorization to provide a potential revenue source, to the extent that housing additional inmates would not affect current staffing needs.

Undersheriff Cook explained that the contract included a right of refusal for the Sheriff based on inmate classification/sentence. Discussion held.

Commissioner Austin made a motion to recommend to the Board of Commissioners to renew the contract with Statewide Security at the new rate of \$29.00 per day/per inmate. Commissioner Hosey seconded the motion.
Motion carried.

Discussion held on progress of collections with Concierge Corrections.

MONTHLY REPORTS

Controller Fuentes submitted for review the monthly report for boarding reimbursement, jail census and court security.

JAIL SECURITY SYSTEM UPDATE

Undersheriff Cook updated the Committee on the completion of the final phase of the jail security system. There is a software module that needs to be completed prior to the Sheriff authorizing final payment on the project.

CENTRAL DISPATCH UPDATE

Controller Fuentes advised the Committee that Director Heinze feels the County 911 plan needs to be reviewed and updated. She is requesting authorization to consult with legal counsel on the review.

MISCELLANEOUS

Commissioner Austin requested acknowledgement for Larry McNair for the organization of the mock disaster drill that was held on September 26, 2015. Discussion held.
A motion was made by Commissioner Hosey that a certificate of recognition be prepared and signed by the Sheriff and the Board Chairperson. Commissioner Rogers seconded the motion.
Motion carried.

Commissioner Whittum acknowledged his appreciation for Captain Robert Jordan of the Corrections Division.

Sheriff Reich advised that the Sheriff's Office Awards Ceremony will be held on January 13th at 6:30 p.m. in the Sheriff's Office Training Room.


