NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED DETACHMENT OF PROPERTY FROM THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE


TO THE RESIDENTS, PROPERTY OWNERS AND ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY OF EATON AND THE VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE, and any other interested parties and persons:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Village President and Village Clerk of the Village of Bellevue have filed with the Eaton County Board of Commissioners a petition regarding the proposed detachment and removal of a parcel of land from the Village of Bellevue, and altering the Village's boundaries accordingly. The parcel of land that is proposed to be detached from the Village of Bellevue is described as follows:

That part of the Southwest $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Town 1 North, Range 6 West, Bellevue Township, Eaton County, Michigan, described as follows: Commencing in the center of Sand Road at a point 992.1 feet East and 363 feet South of West $\frac{1}{4}$ post of said Section 28; thence East 165.00 feet; thence South parallel to the center of Sand Road, 594.12 feet to the place of beginning; thence S $89^{\circ}59'24''$ E, 105.35 feet, more or less to the water's edge of a pond; thence Northerly along the water's edge of said pond, 350 feet, more or less to a point which lies East 165.00 feet from said center of Sand Road; thence South 280 feet, more or less to the place of beginning; Parcel No. 131-028-300-190-00 (the "Property").

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the Eaton County Board of Commissioners will meet on Wednesday, the 18th day of January, 2017, at 7 o'clock, p.m., at the Eaton County Board of Commissioners Room, Eaton County Courthouse, 1045 Independence Blvd., City of Charlotte, County of Eaton, State of Michigan, for the purpose of (1) receiving and considering the Village of Bellevue's petition regarding the proposed detachment of the Property from the Village, and (2) conducting a public hearing regarding the proposed detachment of the Property from the Village. Following the public hearing, the Eaton County Board of Commissioners will determine whether the proposed detachment of the Property from the Village, as requested in the Village's petition, shall be granted.
