The Eaton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session at the County Facilities, in the City of Charlotte, Wednesday, June 12, 2007.

Chairman Brehler called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was given by all.

911 Emergency Service	0.9438 of a mill
Juvenile Justice	0.3973 of a mill
EATRAN	<u>0.2469 of a mill</u>
TOTAL	7.5029
