Minutes of June 7, 2012

The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance given by all.

Commissioner Whittum made a motion to accept the May 3, 2012 minutes as recorded. Commissioner Hosey seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

**LIMITED PUBLIC COMMENT** –

Helen Schneider discussed her continued concerns with the schedule of fines referenced in the Animal Control ordinance.

**REIMBURSEMENT REPORT/ BOARDING UPDATE** – Chief Deputy Peacock

Chief Deputy Peacock discussed the April 2012 Boarding Report. He advised that collections for Parole Violators are 61% and Diverted Felons are 87%, of the budgeted amounts, respectively, to date. Individual Accounts has collected \$66,826, 36.1% of the budget.

The average daily population for the month of May was 238 including an average of 46 from MDOC.

**OVERTIME REPORT UPDATE** – Chief Deputy Peacock

Chief Deputy Peacock discussed the overtime report for payroll period ending 5/31/2012. He advised that overtime shows a favorable variance of \$61,188.02.

**DEPARTMENT UPDATE** – Chief Deputy Peacock

Chief Deputy Peacock introduced Lt. Teresa Catey, promoted as the new Jail Administrator.

## **COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS GRANT** – Marie Douville

Ms. Douville presented the Committee with a resolution to authorize application for a grant for Community Corrections. Commissioner Whittum made a motion to accept the resolution for the Community Corrections grant application. Commissioner Ridge seconded. MOTION CARRIED.

Ms. Douville advised that her department was recently audited by MDOC. The audits were for both administrative and financial.

Commissioner Hosey recommended that Community Corrections use the media to promote projects performed by the Road Crew.

## **MISCELLANEOUS** –

Commissioner Whittum requested a monthly report showing the stats of courthouse visitors and collections of weapons by Courthouse Security.

Commissioner Boles advised that the Response Time Report is no longer needed for the monthly Public Safety Committee meetings.
