() Defendant was convicted of **Felony Firearm**. MCL 750.227b(2)

() Defendant was convicted of **Escape**. MCL 750.193.

() Defendant was **in jail or prison, or on escape status**, when he committed the charged offense. MCL 768.7a(1).

() Defendant was **on parole** when he committed the charged offense. MCL 768.7a(2).

() Defendant committed a **major controlled substance offense** while on bond for another offense. MCL 768.7b(2)(b).

Discretionary Consecutive Sentence:

() Defendant committed the charged offense (not a major controlled substance offense) while **on bond** for another felony. MCL 768.7b(2)(a).

() Defendant's sentence for a **major controlled substance offense** may run consecutive to the sentence for any other felony as long as defendant was not on bond for the other felony when the major controlled substance offense was committed. MCL 333.7401(3). MCL 761.2 defines a "major controlled substance" as a violation of MCL 333.7401(2)(a) or 333.7403(2)(a)(i) to (iv).

() Defendant's sentence for **Home Invasion-1st Degree** may run consecutive with his sentence for any other criminal offense (misdemeanor or felony) arising from the same transaction. MCL 750.110a(8).

() Defendant's sentence for **Criminal Sexual Conduct – 1st Degree**, MCL 750.520b, may run consecutively to any term of imprisonment imposed for any other criminal offense arising from the same transaction.

() Defendant's sentence for a violation of **MCL 750.317 (Second Degree Murder) where death results from the operation of a vehicle, MCL 750.321 (Manslaughter) where death results from the operation of a vehicle, or MCL 257.625(4) (Operating While Intoxicated, Impaired or With Any Amount of a Schedule 1 Controlled Substance Causing Death)** may run consecutively to any term of imprisonment imposed for another a crime resulting in death arising from the same criminal transaction. MCL 769.36.

() **Consecutive Sentencing provisions do not apply.**
