# Federal Regulations for Proper Freon Removal



Freon is colorless, odorless chlorofluorocarbon (CFC) and hydrochlorofluorocarbon refrigerant that has a negative effect on the Earth's ozone layer.

Federal Law requires Freon be removed from refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc. prior to disposal using methods that will not be detrimental to the environment.

Businesses that accept Freon-containing items must have the Freon removed by a licensed contractor and provide certification that the material was handled properly. A good idea since Freon that is released into the atmosphere can deplete the ozone. But this does mean there is an additional cost involved with recycling and disposal of Freon-containing items.

That's where we come in.....

Eaton County Dept. of Resource Recovery developed the Freon Recovery Credit Program to assist Eaton County residents in the proper recycling and disposal of Freon-containing appliances. Just complete the attached form, have the Freon removed by a licensed contractor (see reverse), include the Removal Certificate and mail it to the Department. Reimbursement up to \$15.00 toward the cost of one Freon-containing item per year is allowed.

Its that simple!
