

EATON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
SPECIAL WORKSHOP
FRIDAY, JUNE 29, 2018

The Eaton County Board of Commissioners met for a Special Workshop at the County Facilities, in the City of Charlotte, Friday, June 29, 2018.

Chairman Mulder called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Solar Energy Development and Agricultural Land Presentation by Harmony Gmazel, Government and Public Policy Educator Citizen Planner/Land Use Education, Michigan State University Extension and M. Charles Gould, Agricultural Bioenergy and Energy Conservation Educator, Michigan State University Extension.

Discussion held regarding DCA-3-18-2, proposed amendment to the Eaton County Land Development Code (Zoning Ordinance) to add language applicable to utility solar energy systems.

Dave Shiflett of Geronimo Solar Company of Minnesota and Kathy Webber of Cypress Creek Renewables spoke regarding the maintenance and monitoring of solar panel project sites, agricultural impacts, and property value effects.

Nancy Gensel stated concerns regarding the loss of farmland in Eaton County that will occur with the approval of the proposed language of DCA 3-18-2.
